As I mentioned last month, the Lions of Connecticut have been given an opportunity to run a candidate for election as International Director in Seattle, WA in 2011. I am very proud to announce that District 23A has four official candidates for the position of International Director, and they are as follows:

Each of the three Districts in Connecticut will hold a special convention to elect a single candidate. District 23A will conduct its special convention on Monday, June 14, 2010 at our previously scheduled District Awards Night (time and place to be announced later). Thereafter, a special Multiple District Convention will be held on November 13, 2010 to select a single candidate from the three endorsed District candidates. That name will then be placed in nomination for the position of International Director in Seattle.

What an exciting time this is! In the coming months, the four candidates from our District will be campaigning for your support. It goes without saying that, as Lions, we will give each of these Lions leaders an open door and an open ear. The Charter Night celebration is scheduled for Thursday, March 25<sup>th</sup> at John J.
